Saturday 25th June – 11:00am to 5:00pm

Sunday 26th June – 11:00am to 5:00pm

Protocol

Slots limited to 30 minutes maximum. Although you may continue if no-one is waiting to take over.

Change over at the o'clock and half past.

No booking of slots or sites. There are plenty to go round. First come – First served.

If you choose a site that is not on the above list then please ensure that you will not cause an obstruction or annoyance. Also, please keep reasonably out of earshot of other performers.

You may collect money for yourselves or charity.

Equipment
